FRIDAY 25 JULY 2025

Today we fly to Glasgow via Dubai to celebrate our Celtic roots and enjoy the music and culture of these two great countries.

SATURDAY 26 JULY 2025 (D) GLASGOW

Voco Grand Central Hotel (3 nights)

Glasgow is a port city on the River Clyde in Scotland's western Lowlands. It is famous for its Victorian and Art Nouveau architecture and its prosperous history in the 18th-20th century due to trade and shipbuilding.

Highlights Include:

• Today we arrive in Glasgow to begin our adventure with check in, a light dinner and an early night.

SUNDAY 27 JULY 2025 (B, D) GLASGOW TOUR

Highlights Include:

- City tour of the great architecture, including Glasgow Cathedral, the oldest house in Glasgow, the Italian Centre, the lighthouse, and Buchanan St.
- Welcome dinner and music provided by Bonnie, Marian and Karl.

MONDAY 28 JULY 2025 (B, L) GLASGOW TOUR

- Visit Robbie Burns' house, museum, and birthplace and several sites of relevance to the poet in and around the area.
- Lunch at the Robbie Burns Cafe, before setting off to Kelvin Grove Art Gallery, a favourite location for Antiques Roadshow.

TUESDAY 29 JULY 2025 (B, L, D) GLASGOW - FORT WILLIAM

Glenspean Lodge Hotel (2 nights)

Fort William is a town in the western Scottish Highlands, on the shores of Loch Linnhe. It's known as a gateway to Ben Nevis, the U.K.'s highest peak, and Glen Nevis valley, home to Steall Falls. It is also the home of the Cameron Clan!

Highlights Include:

- It's off to the Highlands to Fort William this morning with a stop at Tarbet for a cruise on beautiful Loch Lomond, followed by lunch.
- Spend some time shopping in Fort William and visit the West Highland Museum.
- Dinner at our hotel this evening.

• WEDNESDAY 30 JULY 2025 (B, L, D) FORT WILLIAM

Highlights Include:

- Cable car ride up Aonach Mor Mountain for view of Ben Nevis with lunch at the top.
- Whisky tasting at Ben Nevis Distillery plus a tour and talk about whisky.
- Dinner at our hotel this evening with a chance to hear some music from our great artists.

THURSDAY 31 JULY 2025 (B, D) FORT WILLIAM - LOCH NESS - INVERNESS

Inverness Palace Hotel (3 nights)

Inverness is a city on Scotland's northeast coast, where the River Ness meets the Moray Firth. It's the largest city and the cultural capital of the Scottish Highlands. Its Old Town features 19th-century Inverness Cathedral, the mostly 18th-century Old High Church and an indoor Victorian Market selling food, clothing and crafts.

- Drive to Inverness through the highlands, stopping to view the Commando Memorial and Fort Augustus with free time for lunch.
- Cruise on Loch Ness to see what we can spot from the boat using sonar, visit the Loch Ness Visitor's Centre plus enjoy great views of the Urquhart Castle ruins.
- Dinner at the hotel on arrival this evening.

FRIDAY 1 AUGUST 2025 (B, D) INVERNESS TOURING

Highlights Include:

- Walking tour of the old town of Inverness including the Victorian markets, the cathedral and Inverness Castle, with free time for lunch.
- Visit to Cawdor Castle, said to be the setting for Shakespeare's Macbeth.
- Dinner at the hotel this evening with a little concert after dinner from our artists.

SATURDAY 2 AUGUST 2025 (B, L, D) FORT GEORGE AND CULLODEN

Highlights Include:

- Visit to the Culloden Moor Visitor Centre, museum and tour of Culloden Battlefield. It is one of the most important battles which was a total and bloody defeat for the Jacobites, ending more than half a century of Jacobite conflict.
- Drive to Fort George which was built in the wake of the Battle of Culloden (1746) as a secure base for King George II's army.
- Dinner at the hotel this evening.

SUNDAY 3 AUGUST 2025 (B) INVERNESS - EDINBURGH

Intercontinental The George, Edinburgh (3 nights) Edinburgh is Scotland's compact, hilly capital. It has a medieval Old Town and elegant Georgian New Town with gardens and neoclassical buildings. Looming over the city is Edinburgh Castle, home to Scotland's crown jewels and the Stone of Destiny, used in the coronation of Scottish rulers.

- It's off to Edinburgh today but not before we enjoy a wonderful day exploring.
- First stop is the Highland Folk Museum for a chance to wander and get a cup of tea. We step back in time and experience life in the Highlands from 1700s to the 1950s with over 35 historical buildings. This is a chance to imagine how your ancestors might have lived.
- Then we stop at the House of Bruar for lunch (own cost) and shopping. This is a wonderful shopping complex, with a food hall, country gifts, clothes, art, antiques. The list goes on......
- Next stop is Scone Castle, the Crowning Place of Scottish Kings and the original home of the Stone of Scone. We learn about the history of this great place.
- Check into our hotel with time for your own dinner this evening.

TUESDAY 5 AUGUST 2025 (B, D) EDINBURGH

Highlights Include:

- Visit the Royal Yacht Britannia, dubbed the most popular attraction in all Scotland.
- Free time to wander on your own and take in the atmosphere of this gorgeous city with its history, bustling streets and buskers.
- Dinner and show *Taste of Scotland*, what a great way to finish our time in Scotland, highland dancing, bagpipes, haggis, the lot!


WEDNESDAY 6 AUGUST 2025 (B) EDINBURGH - DUBLIN

- Medieval feast, show and tour of Bunratty Castle.

THURSDAY 14 AUGUST 2025 (B) ENNIS - ADARE - DINGLE - KILLARNEY

The Ross Hotel, Killarney (3 nights)

Killarney is renowned for its natural beauty and has been a favourite tourist destination since the 18th century. Today, the Jaunting Cars still carry visitors around the scenic highlights and the picturesque laneways are as bright and colourful as ever, but the bustling streets are now lined with independent craft shops, small galleries, traditional pubs and fine restaurants.

Highlights Include:

- Visit to Adare Village with its Tudor-style thatch-roof cottages, an 1840s limestone courthouse and the ruins of three important church centres.
- Stop off in Dingle, the cutest seaside village with free time for lunch and a wander by the harbour.
- Free evening and time to check out the Irish pubs and the music scene, joining in with the locals.

- City Highlights Tour including Muckross House, one of Ireland's popular attractions.

Faithlegg Hotel, Waterford (2 nights)


Waterford is a tourist-friendly city that has rich culture and history, beautiful scenery, great food and drink, warm hospitality, and joyful festivals.
