NOVOTEL SUNSHINE COAST RESORT (4 NIGHTS)




Highlights Include:

Highlights Include:


- Free time to enjoy the pool, shopping or own tours.

TRANSFER - SUNSHINE COAST - NOOSA - RIVER HEADS - FRASER ISLAND


Today we travel to River Heads with a stop at Noosa for shopping or a walk on the beach and your own early lunch before we continue our journey.

It features complex dune systems that are still evolving, and an array of rare and unique features in this sand environment, including dune lakes and tall rainforests.








Highlights at Fraser Island Include:
