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So special is our Southern Lakes and Fiords trip that we have sold it out five times in a row. The Sounds of Silence greet us on our exclusive music charter in the magnificent Doubtful Sound, plus we enjoy 2 nights of luxury with themed concerts in Queenstown.

Imagine a place where the only sounds are birds and the rustle of trees as we enjoy two special events rich in melody: *Music for Romantics* and the next evening, *A Golden Era of Musicals*. We begin in silence and our soloists gradually start to sing. We also enjoy a special tribute to Vera Lynn, with *We'll Meet Again*, an afternoon tea concert on board. We include 2 other premium music events, a *Family Style Soirée* at the Sofitel and *A Concert by Candlelight* in the private chapel at Stoneridge Estate, all with singers John Cameron, Karl Perigo, Lynette Martin and Tizane McEvoy, all encapsulating peace, music and beauty for the senses.



Fiordland Navigator

Day 1: Tuesday 16 October 2018 (L, Aft/tea, D)

We fly into Queenstown for our late morning coach departure to Manapouri. We travel by coach to *The Fiordland Navigator*, ours exclusively chartered for the next 2 nights. Doubtful Sound is the second largest of Fiordland National Parks famous for its silent isolation, rugged wilderness and incredible peace.

HIGHLIGHTS include:

- Magnificent drive through stunning countryside to Lake Manapouri.
- Cruise across its tranquil waters while having lunch.
- Tour the Manapouri Underground Power Station, located deep beneath Fiordland, subject to availability.
- Journey to Deep Cove, drinking in the beauty of the thickest rainforests of Fiordland and the alpine moss gardens in all their colourful splendour.
- Time for resting and cruising before dinner and our concert, *Music for Romantics*. We begin in silence, and then our soloists gradually start to sing.

DAY 2: Wednesday 17 October 2018 (B, L, D)

We enjoy our own version of paradise!

HIGHLIGHTS include:

- Cruising to view the NZ fur seals, some kayaking or exploring in smaller boats, a Naturalist talk about sights, bird life and fauna, and Captain's talk about the adventures of Captain Cook plus time to simply enjoy the scenery.
- After lunch in the dining room we are treated to *We'll Meet Again*, our tribute to Vera Lynn, presented by Tizane, Karl and Penny whilst we partake in a high tea.
- Following our dinner, we present the most beautiful melodies in *A Golden Era of Musicals* and they in turn echo off the hard surfaces of nature's most beautiful masterpiece.

DAY 3: Thursday 18 October 2018 (B, L, D)
