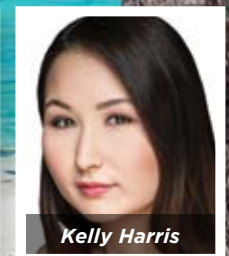
Experience the Exceptional...
